



# MAHANA

## *Méthode Traditionelle NV Brut*

Mahana ("warm place") is the traditional Maori name for the land where Woollaston Estates winery is now built. Originally a premium apple growing area, the Mahana vineyard is now planted in classic grape varieties.

### TASTING NOTES

This wine has a fine mousse, with attractive bready notes, complementing the core fruit characters that yield to an elegant texture and a dry finish.

### WINEMAKING NOTES

Made in a Brut style employing traditional techniques from a blend of 50% Chardonnay and 50% Pinot Noir. The wine spent 24 months bottle ageing on the yeast lees after bottle fermentation.
